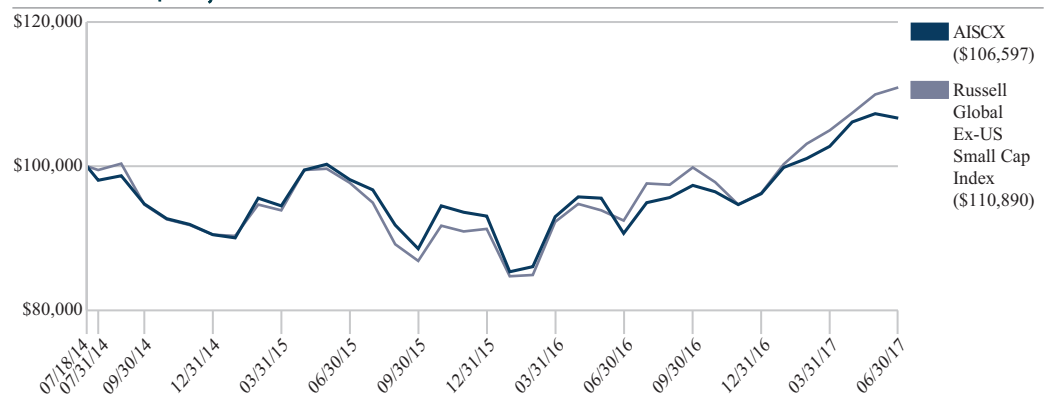

As stated in the current prospectus, the Fund's annual operating expense ratio (gross) is 2.16%. However, the Fund's adviser has agreed to limit its investment advisory fee and reimburse expenses such that total operating expenses (excluding all taxes, interest, portfolio transaction expenses, acquired fund fees and expenses, proxy expenses and extraordinary expenses) do not exceed 1.50%, which is in effect until November 1, 2017, otherwise performance shown would have been lower. Shares redeemed or exchanged within 60 days of purchase will be charged a 1.00% fee.

Market Capitalization is the aggregate value of all a company's outstanding equity securities. **Median Market Cap** gives a measure of the size of companies in which a mutual fund invests. Half the companies in the fund have a market capitalization larger than this number, and half have a market cap that is smaller. (Market capitalization is just the total market value of all outstanding shares.) **Trailing Price Earning Ratio (P/E)** is the sum of a company's price-to-earnings, calculated by taking the current stock price and dividing it by the trailing earnings per share for the past 12 months. **Price-to-Cash Flow** is used to evaluate the price of a company's stock as compared to the amount of cash flow it generates. **Price-to-Book Ratio** is used to compare a stock's market value to its book value. Book value is the total asset of a company minus total liability.

The Russell® Global Ex-U.S. Small Cap Index is constructed to provide a comprehensive and unbiased barometer for the small-cap segment and is completely reconstituted annually to accurately reflect the changes in the market over time. You cannot invest directly into an index.
